Greenwich Mencap is a local registered member-led charity that works with and for people with learning disabilities and/or autism and their families in the Royal Borough of Greenwich.

We have an exciting role within our Greenlights Project working directly with families and other professionals.

The Greenlights service is an innovative behaviour support service funded by City Bridge, Garfield, and Western. The service provides support within the family home for families with children aged 0-11 who have a learning disability and/or autism and present with challenging behaviours.

The Greenlights behaviour specialist supports families who are experiencing behavioural difficulties from their child. They will help the family develop coping strategies and behaviour management skills, understand and manage sibling rivalry, and improve communication skills. The specialist will also deliver workshops and NVR training to help families understand and manage challenging behaviour.
