


















	<p>Greenwich + Dockland’s International Festival want to work with Learning Disabled + Neurodivergent creatives!</p>
  	<p>GDIF is a free outdoor festival of Theatre, circus, dance and more.</p> <p>It happens in Greenwich and East London from 21st August – 6th September 2026</p> <p>You can see more about the festival in this video</p>
   	<p>We have 5 paid roles for local learning disabled and neurodivergent creatives, to help promote the 2026 festival and host audiences at one of our events.</p> <p>You will help us invite more learning disabled people to the festival.</p> <p>You will also help us improve access at the festival.</p> <p>You can learn more about access at GDIF in this video</p>

   	<p>You will take part in 4 creative workshops:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Introduction to GDIF 2026: <i>shows, access and more!</i> (May) 2. Access + Planning: <i>accessibility at Greenwich Fair, planning the route and how we invite people</i> (June) 3. Promoting + Practising: <i>creating promo videos, role play of hosting, and telling people about the festival</i> (July) 4. Festival Briefing: <i>training and what to expect on site</i> (August) <p>Each workshop will be 2.5 hours long and take place in person. Times, dates and location to be confirmed.</p>
	<p>In the months before the festival, you will share information about GDIF to your community.</p> <p>You will help us invite lots of learning disabled audiences to the festival.</p>

  	<p>At the festival you will help host a guided route around Greenwich Fair in Greenwich Park on 22nd/23rd August.</p> <p>You will welcome and support audiences with access requirements and guide them around lots of fun shows.</p> <p>You can see more about Greenwich Fair in this video.</p>
	<p>After the festival you will take part in a feedback session. You will share your experience and tell us how it could be improved.</p>
	<p>You will be paid £320 for the project in total</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • £40 for each workshop • £20 for the site visit • £100 for your role on site at Greenwich Fair • £40 for the feedback session <p>Alternative arrangements for payment can be made if needed.</p>

	<p>We are looking for people who:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Live in South East or East London 2. Are over 18 years old 3. Like to be creative and are interested in theatre, dance or performance 4. Are part of social groups in their local area 5. Are available on 22nd and 23rd August and to take part in monthly workshops (days tbc)
